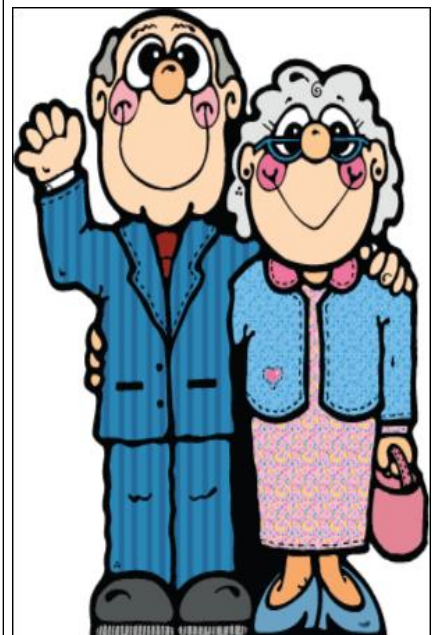

# Hurricane Ida - Presbyterian Disaster Assistance

*Therefore, we will not fear, though the waters roar and foam. (Psalm 46)*

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance is delivering immediate aid to those impacted by Hurricane Ida. Initial assessment suggests catastrophic destruction from the storm and widespread power outages that are expected to take weeks to fully restore. PDA will continue to work with Presbyterian leadership as they respond to Hurricane Ida and remain engaged in the recovery from the hurricane season of 2020, during which seven named storms impacted the region. After initial needs are addressed, PDA will remain — providing emotional and spiritual care and Long-Term Recovery to address unmet needs.

**The needs for the response will be great. God's people are once again called on to stand in the "GAP" — Give. Act. Pray.**

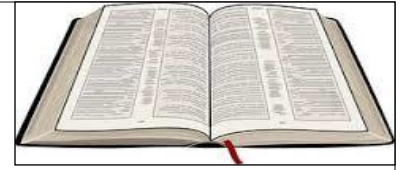
