



## One More Thing... Guidelines for the Relationship of Departing Pastors and Their Former Congregations

Friends, the time for my departure is drawing near - I will lead worship for the last time on September 10<sup>th</sup> and my final day in the church office will be the 12<sup>th</sup>. There are a few matters that need to be addressed before my last day with you.

The Presbytery of Northern Kansas has important guidelines for you and me to follow as I leave this ministry. Some of these may be difficult, but they are important to the health of the congregation. Generally, I agree with these guidelines and will follow them – I hope you will do likewise. The guidelines can be made available upon request form the Clerk of Session. Here is a brief quote that address important issues:

"When a pastor resigns from a pastorate, retires from service, or becomes Pastor Emerita/us, that minister shall no longer perform pastoral functions such as weddings, baptisms, funerals, hospital visitation, or counseling. Active or inactive church members shall not request a former pastor to perform pastoral duties. If requested, the (former) pastor shall tactfully decline. On occasion, the (currently serving) pastor or moderator (at the church) may, with the approval of session/council invite the former pastor to perform such duties."


Regarding social media, the Commission on Ministry suggests that pastors not accept friend requests from congregation members for at least one year after departure. "Following that year, it is best to not initiate contact via social media with any former congregation members and to firmly redirect any and all attempts to seek pastoral care." Following the first year – in accordance with these guidelines – I will not be the one to *initiate* friend/follow requests on social media.

You have a great group of leaders in your session, deacons, and staff – please support them in this time of transition. I trust you will soon find new pastoral leadership and avenues to extend your mission and God's welcome. Trust each other, lean on each other and into the future God has planned for you.
